The first years, I carried the responsibility for the computer networks, custom developments and general IT policy of several small businesses in Antwerp and Brussels (5 – 50 workstations). No need to say that, as much as I may have known about computers; running a business, communicating with seasoned colleagues as well as novice users, finishing projects and getting clients satisfied was a whole new experience.

The need to specialize –and my personal interests- made me gradually turn back to my roots and by the end of the year 2000, I ended all SME contracts and focused solely on developing database and administrative applications using Microsoft technologies (such as ASP, Visual Basic, SQL server and later .Net).
